The Little Princess Trust was set up in Hereford in 2005 in memory of Hannah Tarplee. A year earlier, Hannah had been diagnosed with a Wilms Tumour and the loss of her hair was especially traumatic.

Her parents felt the most fitting tribute to the five-year-old would be a charity dedicated to providing wigs to children who had lost their own hair through cancer treatment and other conditions.

The Little Princess Trust was born and the charity has now provided wigs to more than 15,000 young people.

The charity is also one of the largest funders of childhood cancer research in the UK and, since 2016, has given more than £20million to projects focused on finding kinder and more effective treatments for childhood cancers
