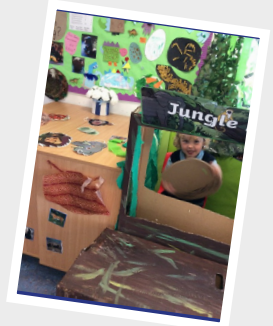
YEAR 1

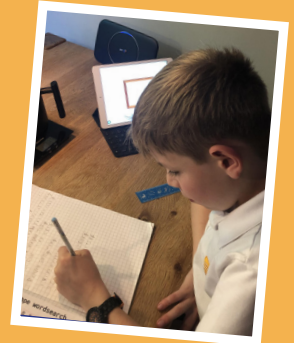
YEAR 5 PGL TRIP REMINDER

YEAR 4 MATHS

In Maths Year 4 have been working on metric measures. They have been converting between metric units of length, mass and capacity. In their homework task they were asked to find, and weigh, a variety of different objects. Many of the children sent in photos of them completing the activity. It looks like great fun was had by all creatures great and small!



At school we have taken advantage of the lovely weather to bring our work outside. The children investigated whether there is a correlation between height, arm span & foot length and the distance between elbow & wrist. They discovered, that for most people, the difference is very small although, a few had arm spans significantly greater than their height. We discussed whether this could be due to measuring errors or whether they were in fact related to orangutans!
