Boys' Uniform:

School blazer with badge and navy pin striped trousers supplied by Clubsport

Plain white long-sleeved shirt

An authorised school tie in the appropriate House colours

Regulation long and/or sleeveless navy V-neck sweater with HCS badge supplied by Clubsport (optional)

Medium grey socks

Black 'leather' polishable shoes (not boots)

Navy school scarf, navy gloves (both optional)

Summer Term

Pupils may assume 'shirt-sleeve' order during the summer term when the Headmaster's notice is posted which permits them to do so this means: No blazer, no pullover, shirt sleeves may be neatly rolled up.

Sixth Form Boys' Uniform:

Plain or pin-striped dark grey, black or navy suit

A formal and sober-coloured shirt

An authorised Sixth Form school tie available from Clubsport

A plain coloured V-neck or crew-neck pullover

Plain dark-coloured socks and black 'leather' shoes that can be polished

A plain dark grey, black or navy wool-mixture coat, waterproof or fleece

Scarves should be in keeping with business-like dress

A white shirt must be worn for the Commemoration Service, 'Speeches', the Carol Service and on other occasions when required by the Headmaster.

Boy's Games Kit

Each boy in Years 7 to 10 must have:

Navy blue HCS tracksuit, navy blue HCS rugby shorts, navy blue reversible HCS rugby shirt, white HCS PE shorts, white HCS polo shirt, HCS rugby socks, white ankle socks, white cricket shirt, white cricket pullover, rugby boots, trainers, mouth guard and shin pads. An extra pair of trainers is recommended for Cross Country.

(The Canterbury range of HCS kit from Clubsport is available to pupils from Year 9 and above).

Boys in Year 11 and Sixth Form should have Sports kit appropriate to their activity:

Rugby and Hockey - Navy blue HCS tracksuit, navy blue HCS rugby shorts, navy blue HCS training t-shirt, HCS rugby socks, mouth guard.

Cross-country, Badminton, Athletics and Tennis - Navy blue HCS tracksuit, white or navy HCS polo shirt, white shorts and white ankle socks.

Girls' Uniform:

School blazer with badge; regulation navy pin-striped knee length skirt supplied by Clubsport
Regulation three-quarter sleeved white blouse supplied by Clubsport
Regulation long and/or sleeveless navy V-neck sweater with HCS badge supplied by Clubsport (optional)
Navy, black or flesh coloured tights
Black 'leather' polishable shoes, with a maximum heel height of 5cm/2 inches
Trainers or soft shoes for drama.
School scarf or pashmina, both available from Clubsport and navy gloves (all optional)
HCS jacket from Clubsport (optional)
Girls may wear a discreet gold or silver chain, with or without a cross.
For Years 7 and 8 the wearing of make-up and other jewellery is prohibited.
However, girls with pierced ears may wear a pair of small, plain, silver or gold studs.
For Years 9 to 11 make-up, if worn, must be discreet and nail varnish must be clear.
Hair accessories must be simple and business-like, plain navy or gold.

Summer Term:

Girls may wear short white ankle socks in the summer term
Pupils may assume 'shirt-sleeve' order during the summer term when the Headmaster's notice is posted which permits them to do so
This means: No blazer, no pullover, shirt sleeves may be neatly rolled up

Sixth Form Girls' Uniform:

Plain or pin-striped dark grey, black or navy skirt or trouser suit
No extreme lengths of skirt are acceptable
A formal and sober-coloured blouse with collar
A plain coloured V-neck or crew-neck pullover
Navy or black 'leather' or patent shoes that can be polished, with a maximum heel height of 5 cm/2 inches
Scarves should be in keeping with business-like dress
Make-up and jewellery, if worn, should be discreet
Nail varnish should be clear; nose or tongue studs are not permitted
Navy, black or flesh-coloured tights
A white blouse must be worn for the Commemoration Service, 'Speeches', the Carol Service and on other occasions when required by the Headmaster

Girl's Games Kit

Each girl in Years 7 to 10 must have:

Navy blue HCS skort, HCS gold games shirt (short sleeve), navy blue HCS tracksuit bottoms and/or navy blue HCS leggings, navy blue HCS tracksuit top and/or navy blue HCS hoody, navy blue HCS hockey socks, white ankle socks, trainers (astros optional), shin pads, mouth guard. An extra pair of trainers is recommended for Cross Country. (The Canterbury range of HCS kit from Clubsport is available to pupils from Year 9 and above).

Girls in Year 11 and Sixth Form should have Sports kit appropriate to their activity:

Netball and Hockey - Navy blue HCS netball/hockey top, navy blue HCS tracksuit bottoms and/or navy blue HCS leggings, HCS hoody, navy blue HCS skort, gold HCS senior hockey socks, mouth guard and shin pads.

Cross-country, Badminton, Rounders, Athletics and Tennis - Navy blue HC track suit bottoms and/or navy blue HCS leggings, navy blue HCS hoody, navy blue HCS skort, navy blue HCS polo top and white ankle socks.
