



## PTA REPS MAY 2013

Feedback from last meeting.

- i. School Uniform Shop. The school has arranged for a new supplier to open a shop in Hereford. This will ensure that the uniform is more readily available and quicker to order. We are also taking the opportunity to review the uniform list and the various suppliers, which will result in a lower price for a number of items. Further details will follow in due course.
- ii. Second hand uniform sale. A detailed scheme is now in place and the new store is in operation.
- iii. PTA Photoshop. This is now up to date and we will continue to update as photos are put on our system at school.
- iv. Sandwiches at lunchtime. We have been monitoring the children – there has been no further feedback from parents.

1. What about our plans for Y3 next term? A letter with full details has already been sent out.
2. Could the Pre-Prep wear trousers?  
The boys in Pre-Prep have traditionally worn shorts, adding tracksuit trousers when it is cold. However, we are happy to look at this as part of the review of uniform. Boys are welcome to come to school in tracksuit bottoms and change in the classroom on arrival. I was asked what we meant by 'dark grey' trousers – we will make the new list more specific.  
One of the girls in Y5 has been asking about changing the girls' uniform and I am hoping that she is going to help organise a questionnaire next term. The feeling at the meeting was that those present were broadly happy with the girls' uniform and were not in favour of a change to trousers.
3. Are Pre-Prep children allowed to take their coats off during lunch?  
When the children all wear their coats to lunch they do tend to sit with them on. We have no objection to them taking them off and then sitting on them but it may be that staff have asked them not to take them off to avoid coats getting lost. Now that this has been brought to our attention, Mrs Lord will ensure that staff know that children are allowed to take their coats off.
