Dear Parents,

As part of our Science topic on 'Adaptation', Year 6 will be travelling to Bristol Zoo on Friday 28th June 2019. The visit will provide time for the children to view the various enclosures at the zoo, completing a quiz style booklet as they go and attend a workshop on 'Adaptation' in the Education Centre.

Children should wear white PE kit and full school tracksuit. Please bring a small day sack and pack a light rain coat if the forecast is poor. Pupils may bring a non-fizzy drink and snack to eat on arrival at the zoo. There may be an opportunity to visit the shop in which case your child may bring spending money of no more than £5. A packed lunch will be provided for those who normally have a school lunch. Please note that children should not bring any electronic items on the trip, including phones, iPods etc.

Please drop your child off in **Broad Street at 8.00am**. Pick-up will be from school at 5.00pm.

Choristers will be taken to the zoo separately, in a school minibus driven by a member of staff. The children will be collected from the Cathedral in the usual way and returned in time for choir rehearsal in the afternoon.

If your child requires travel sickness tablets, please ensure they take these at the appropriate time before departure and tablets for the return journey may be given to Dr Barber in a labelled envelope.
